Her tear-resistant resort map is stored in two plastic poles (ca. 13.5 cm long) and can be rolled up and unrolled conveniently – even with gloves on. Inside the jacket, this device needs little space and is ready for action whenever you need orientation in the mountains. MyWay is a perfect adaptation of an age-old invention. No doubt, the old Egyptians would be thrilled."
